
# Where do we stand?

#### Spring 2013 survey findings

In spring 2013, 89% of CHC employees participated in the i.C.A.R.E. Employee Engagement survey administered by the Gallup Organization and here are the results:

- We achieved 70th percentile (4.38 Grand Mean)
- 69% of CHC employees are engaged at work
- The number of engaged employees to actively disengaged is 11.5 to 1, well above World Class designation
- CHC Nurses are at the 75th percentile of the Gallup RN database
- 56% of CHC Departments are at Best Practice designation
- 29% of CHC Departments are at World Class designation
- 57% of CHC workgroups increased their Grand Mean score by .20 or more

#### Our path to a stronger workplace

Since Spring 2011, we have focused on Q8: Mission/Purpose — emphasizing how each employee's job relates to CHC's mission — and our efforts have paid off. Our grand mean score moved .32 between 2011 and 2013, which is substantial progress.

Earlier this year, we held the WeCanStruction Contest with overwhelming participation! There were 43 department entries, and we collected 8,273 food items that were donated to the Bowling Green, Franklin, and Scottsville communities. We made a difference in the fight against hunger and malnutrition in the communities we serve!

The majority of CHC employees responded either Strongly Agree or Agree to each Q12 item. By working together, we are creating a better environment for each of us and for our patients, their families and our communities.


#### Where do we go from here:


