## New Processes and Software to Improve Efficiency and Meet Meaningful Use Guidelines

### New Process: March

In March, Sovera will be retired and all signing of reports, reviewing patient charts and documents, and viewing deficiency lists will be done exclusively in Meditech. This new process will require a brief physician training (approximately 30 minutes). Come to one of the following locations any time during the training hours:

#### February 18–March 1 (Monday through Friday):

### New Software for Meaningful Use: Summer 2013

The Meaningful Use initiative is a set of standards defined by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services Incentive Programs, which allows eligible providers and hospitals to earn incentive payments by meeting specific criteria. In April, The Medical Center at Bowling Green will complete the transition to Computerized Physician Order Entry (CPOE) and Patient Problem List. The “go-live” for this initiative is planned for the summer of 2013. Physician training will take place in April. More details about this initiative and training will be forthcoming. Details about training and implementation are also being planned for The Medical Center at Scottsville and The Medical Center at Franklin.
